

## Ration Distribution

# RATION DISTRIBUTION

A months supply of dry ration was distributed to 202 families. These were all chosen from the poorest of the poor and the most vulnerable in the local villages. The assessment was done based on the beneficiary survey form (attached).

The criteria for selection were as follows:

- Mahadalit(rat-eater) families
- Widows
- Orphans
- Palliative care patients and families
- Mental Health patients and families
- Persons with Disability and families
- Stranded migrant farmers
- Pregnant/lactating mothers
- Small farmers/daily wage laborers

The ration pack contained the following items:

- Rice - 25 Kg
- Lentils- 5 Kg
- Salt - 1 Kg
- Oil - 1 Kg
- Sattu (ground and roasted chickpea) - 3 Kg
- Washing soap - 2Kg
- Bathing soap - 2 nos

# SHED AND RENOVATION OF TRIAGE AREA

Thanks to the grant, we were able to make important improvements to the triage area. With the rainy season starting, the previous tarpaulins used to keep away the sun would get damaged with every rain. We were able to erect a tin shed to provide shelter for the patients from the elements. Additionally, we made modifications to the interior to break down a wall and make a room for examination of patients. Pictures of these are attached as well as the bills. We converted the Old Community Health Office into a triage centre, where we screen all our patients to reduce the number of patients who come into the hospital. Those with Influenza-like Illnesses are referred for the time being until we can complete the building of the first floor of the RCTC building which will become our Corona hospital for the duration of the pandemic. We are also planning to renovate our dharamsala to improve social distancing among the relatives of the patients.

# MASKS AND PPE MAKING

We have made 90 PPE sets till date and 20000 masks. The PPE sets are being used on a daily basis in the triage and in the COVID areas. They are then sterilized and reused. The masks are being distributed to patients and in the villages. As part of the PPE we also bought scrub suits for the staff as it is not safe for them to use their own clothes as the infection is spreading. The costs for PPE making are as follows.
